

2013 Midwest Tour Trucks rulebook

Conduct

Drivers are expected to take the race seriously, Drivers not abiding by the Code of Conduct will be given ONE warning to stop. If the misconduct continues you will be asked to park. Failure to do so will result in a suspension depending on how severe the problem is the suspension length could vary.

APPEARANCE

A professional appearing paint job in an attractive color required. All lettering must be professional and in good taste. No more than 50% of an area can be used for decals. All dark colored cars must have ample light colored lettering or numbers to improve visibility. Poorly painted, poorly visible, or poorly lettered cars will not be able to race until corrected. Pornographic, racist, or otherwise inflammatory paint schemes are prohibited.

Consolation races/ Last Chance Race procedures

The top 7 slowest drivers in qualifying will race in a Consolation race for 12 laps and the drivers that finish in the top 4 positions will move onto the last chance. The last chance race is 15 laps the winners of the Consolation race will start in the back of the last chance race, the top 2 positions in last chance race will move onto the Feature race. The two drivers that transferred from the last chance race will start in the back of the Feature Race.

BY NOT FOLLOWING ANY OF THE RULES ABOVE YOU COULD GET TERMINATED FROM THE RACING SERIES. ONCE YOU START RACING YOU HAVE AUTOMATICALLY AGREED TO ALL THESE REQUIREMENTS AND RULES.
